GENERAL INFORMATION

Description

The Fritids after school activities association "not for profit", run by a board of parent volunteers. Sign up for classes takes place each semester (in August and in January). Contact: fritids@rygaards.com or see website www.rygaardsfritid.com for more information.

Expectations

Fritids is an enrichment programme not a childcare provider. Fritids administer the enrolment to the activities but cannot collect/return children or provide supervision before classes start, this is parents' responsibility. If your child attends Caterpillars or Butterflies aftercare there is no provision to take them to and from our activities - please do not sign up to Fritids unless you are able to do this yourself.

If your child attends the anneks SFO in the main SFO building you MUST indicate this in the box in your profile. You must check your child's profile each semester to update their information as this is not automatically updated in the system (class, age of child, SFO etc). We do not have access to the Rygaards school pupil information so rely on parents inputting correct personal information at Fritids registration.

- Registration is binding and non-refundable. There are no trial classes.
- It is not possible to switch between music teachers once the semester has begun.
- We reserve the right to cancel classes or make changes to classes if deemed necessary.
- We regret that activities can only run if there is sufficient enrolment for a viable class.
- Rygaards Fritids reserves the right to dismiss children who repeatedly disrupt the classes, without reimbursing the fee.
- Teachers are contracted to Fritids each semester.
- Refunds/replacement classes are <u>not</u> provided if students need to miss class (ie for school trips, sports matches, illness, travel, school events or any other such reason).
- on days when school finishes early, generally Fritids will still operate (check if unsure)

Required Materials

All materials are provided unless otherwise stated. For sports /dance children should wear comfortable clothing & footwear appropriate for the activity.

For piano, guitar, ukulele, drums we have available to use for woodwind - students require own instruments, we sell a beginner 'toot flute' 280kr, to flute pupils if required

Absence

Lessons missed because of the child's absence (due to student illness, travelling, school trips, school performances, sports match etc.) will not be replaced or reimbursed, this includes music classes. In the unusual event of activity cancellation (e.g. teacher sickness) a notice will be sent to parents via email or SMS. Catch up lesson or reimbursement* will follow in this case. It is parents' responsibility to keep their contact details up to date. SMS can only be sent to DK phone numbers. *Refunds are calculated & paid out at the end of each semester.

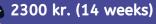

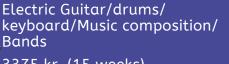
